St. Andrew's is committed to providing education to all children and adults on a weekly basis. Each year, hundreds of parishioners of all ages attend Bible Study, Church School classes, dramatic productions, nursery care, Inquirers classes, Confirmation classes, Baptism Preparation classes, and the ever popular Lenten Film Series.

Without the continued financial support of the Annual Giving campaign, St. Andrew's would not be able to continue to enrich so many lives each week.

THE CHURCH SCHOOL
