## DIOCESAN ASSESSMENT

We give more than \$96,000 to the Diocese of Michigan for support of the larger Church.

This is a fixed cost that the diocese calculates based on a 3-year average of our budget. This assessment is the majority of our outreach budget.

"So then, whenever we have an opportunity, **let us work for the good of all**, and especially for those of the family of faith." Galatians 6:10

The practice of outreach is so much more than just giving money! St. Andrew's participates in a number of parish-wide "in-kind" outreach projects throughout the year which cover a wide range of interests.

Popular "in-kind" outreach projects include: contribute to the Episcopal Relief and Development fund after a natural disaster, provide hats for the Breakfast's Santa Day, purchase a Christmas gift for a local family in need, fill a grocery bag with food for Food Gatherers, help build with Habitat for Humanity, and volunteer at the Breakfast.

## THE BREAKFAST

The Breakfast is an independent non-profit but works closely with the church.

We often share expenses such as the installation of a new door in Parish Hall, splitting plumbing bills, and custodial services.


